


Percent distribution of adults by tobacco use, Tripura 2016-17



About GATS

The Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS) is a global standard for systematically monitoring adult tobacco use (smoking and smokeless) and tracking key tobacco control indicators.

GATS is a household survey of persons 15 years of age and older conducted in all 30 states of India and two Union Territories. The first round of GATS was conducted between June 2009 and January 2010. The second round of GATS was conducted between August 2016 to February 2017 by Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Mumbai for Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India. A multi-stage sample design was used for both rounds of GATS. From each of the sampled households, one household member 15 years of age and older was randomly selected for individual interview. In Tripura, a total of 765 males and 794 females were interviewed during September - October 2016.



GATS 2 Highlights


- 44.4% of men, 10.3% of women and 27.7% of all adults currently smoke tobacco.
- 40.8% of men, 56.5% of women and 48.5% of all adults currently use smokeless tobacco.
- 67.5% of men, 61.4% of women and 64.5% of all adults either smoke tobacco and/or use smokeless tobacco.
- Among all the states and two union territories where GATS 2 was conducted, the highest prevalence of any type of tobacco as well as smokeless tobacco use is reported in Tripura.
- From GATS 1 to GATS 2, there is no significant change in the prevalence of smoking; but the prevalence of smokeless tobacco use has increased significantly by seven percentage points. The use of tobacco has increased significantly by nine percentage points from 55.9% in GATS 1 to 64.5% in GATS 2.
- Betel quid with tobacco and bidi are the two most commonly used tobacco products; 39.5% of adults use betel quid with tobacco and 19.3% smoke bidi.
- The prevalence of tobacco use among persons aged 15-17 has decreased from 15.8% in GATS 1 to 11.6% in GATS 2.
- 64.3% of smokers were advised by a health care provider to quit smoking and 38.8% of smokeless tobacco users were advised by a health care provider to quit use of smokeless tobacco.
- 25.0% of all adults who worked indoors were exposed to second-hand smoke at their workplace.
- 13.6% of all adults were exposed to second-hand smoke at any public place⁷.
- 60.5% of cigarette smokers and 51.1% of bidi smokers thought of quitting smoking because of warning label. 48.2% of smokeless tobacco users thought of quitting smokeless tobacco use because of warning label.








Age at initiation of tobacco use, smoking and smokeless tobacco




Prevalence of smoking and smokeless tobacco use by age group, GATS Tripura 2016-17 (Figures in Percentages)





Percent distribution of adults by tobacco use status, GATS Tripura 2016-17




Prevalence of most commonly used tobacco products among all adults, GATS Tripura 2016-17 (Figures in Percentages)





Percent distribution of daily tobacco users by time to first tobacco use of the day, GATS Tripura 2016-17


