Public Interest Litigation Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed herein, the High Court will be pleased to issue a Writ. Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of "Writ of Mandamus" or any other direction directing the Respondents to implement Regulation 2.3.4 of the FSS Regulations and ban the manufacture, storage, sale and distribution of gutkha, pan masala and all other forms of chewing tobacco containing Tobacco and Nicotine as ingredients, by whatsoever name it is available in the market, as per the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restrictions on Sales) Regulations, 2011, in the interest of public health;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI P.RADHIVE\_REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and of the learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the Advocate General for the respondents, the Court made the following:

### ORDER:

Learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the Advocate General submitted that steps have already been taken in the matter and according to him, the sale of gutka and pan masala have already been banned in the State. However, he will obtain necessary instructions in the matter.

In view of that, after considering the submissions made before us, we only direct that if not, already a notification has been issued by the Andhra Pradesh State Government, the State Government may now
